Mais il leur est le plus souvent hostile, blasphémateur et sacrilège. Le païer se caractérise par son altérité par rapport aux religions monothéistes - judaïsme, christianisme et islam qui le désignent par ce mot. Le pape Grégoire le Grand (590-604) va plus loin et invite à transformer les lieux de culte païens en lieux de culte chrétiens : des études archéologiques présentées ici attestent que cela s'est fait. Et la remarquable correspondance d'Alcuin

dont le vocabulaire est très finement analysé, permet de saisir ses conceptions de la conversion des païens, saxons et avars en particulier, dans la continuité d'Augustin et de Grégoire.
